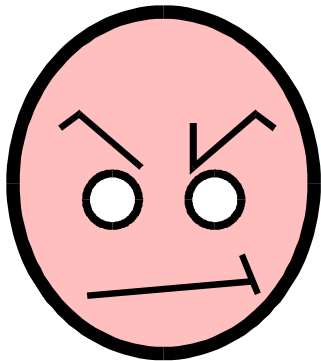

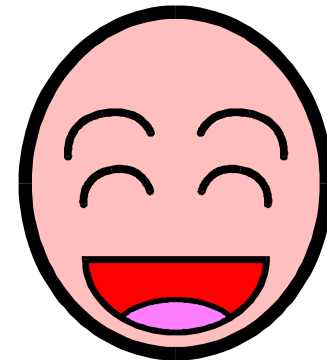
- “Ethics in learning” in the broadest sense

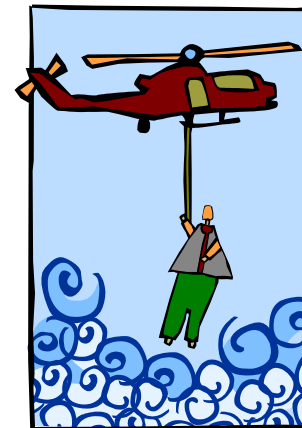

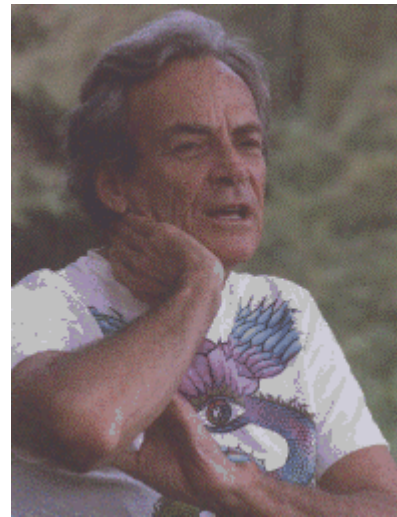
